Ahhh! Remember hot summer days, curled up on a comfy chair, reading the latest adventures of Nancy Drew? Would you believe that for over 86 years, boys and girls have been enjoying Nancy Drew mystery stories? Tara Rotuna will join us at our May meeting, on May 12, to present *Nancy Drew: The History Behind the Mystery*. Tara will entertain us about our favorite childhood sleuth and answer questions, such as: What is the history behind our favorite girl? Who created Nancy Drew? Who is Carolyn Keene? and more!

Ms. Rotuna, herself, began reading and collecting Nancy Drew books at the age of eight. Attending a Nancy Drew convention in 2008 prompted her to learn more about the history of the series and inspired her to write and deliver presentations at local libraries for the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Nancy Drew. She delivered an expanded and enhanced presentation for the 85<sup>th</sup> anniversary. As an involved member of her community, Tara served on the

Monroeville Public Library Board from 2011 to 2015. She continues to volunteer for library events and fundraisers, and holds a seat on the Advisory Board of the Spectrum Charter School. Professionally, she has held positions as a technical writer, process engineer, and IT analyst. She is currently a business analyst for ConsultUSA.

We are looking forward to hearing Tara Rotuna tell of Nancy Drew's history and to learn how our favorite girlhood sleuth has influenced the paths and lives of some accomplished women.
